Alessandro Iovino (Naples, 1986) published his first book at the age of nineteen. He graduated in history with a thesis then published under the title " L'apogeo di Stalin. Breve storia dell'Unione Sovietica dal 1945 al 1953" [The apogee of Stalin. Brief history of the Soviet Union from 1945 to 1953] (Florence Atheneum, 2009) with preface by the life senator Giulio Andreotti, former president of the Council of Ministers of the Italian Republic. With this book he

was ranked first for the essay section at the Literary Award "Letizia Isaia" 2009, finalist at the XXVI edition of the "Firenze Prize" and finalist at the "Vladimir Nabokov" International Prize 2009. He specialized in modern and contemporary history with a thesis on history of the Pentecostal movement from Campania with 110 cum laude, then published in the book "Liberi per servire. Le Assemblee di Dio nella storia repubblicana" [Free to serve. The Assemblies of God in Republican History] (EUN, Varese, 2017).

He has 15 publications. He was, among other things, the ghostwriter with Sondra Sottile of the biography of Edinson Cavani, top football player, "'Quello che ho nel cuore" [What I have in my heart] (Mondadori, 2011) also translated into Spanish. In 2013 he published "Andreotti e il potere. Il divo Giulio visto da vicino" [Andreotti and the power. The Divine Giulio seen closely](Bonferraro). He was awarded with prestigious awards in more than twenty literary prizes and in 2013 he received the "Masaniello - Neapolitani protagonisti" Prize. His book "Licio Gelli. Il burattinaio d'Italia" [Licio Gelli.The puppeteer of Italy](Graus, Naples, 2015) has been defined by national press agencies as "a true act of courage", so as to receive a holograph message of appreciation and praise from the President of the Italian Republic Sergio Mattarella. In 2017 he published "Grazie Bud. Bud Spencer tra fede, filosofia, l'amore per Napoli e racconti di vita" [Thank you Bud. Bud Spencer between faith, philosophy, love for Naples and stories of life] (Eternity, Naples, 2017). Following the dispatch of the book at the Elysee Palace, Alessandro Iovino, he receives a holographic message from the President of the Republic Emmanuel Macron in December 2017.

He was a speaker at conferences, conventions and international events in Italian and foreign locations (France, Hungary, Germany, USA, Singapore).

He has been referent in Campania of CESNUR of Turin (Center of Studies on New Religions) from 2008 to 2011.

Since 2015 he is a journalist. He was a parliamentary assistant at the Senate of the Republic from 2011 to 2018.

In November 2015 he was among the promoters of a historic convention at the Senate of the Republic to celebrate the abolition of a fascist era circular that prohibited Pentecostal worship. On this occasion also Former Attorney General US John David Ashcroft intervened,



who gave Iovino an exclusive interview about the events of September 11, 2001, when Aschcroft was Attorney General. For the occasion, Iovino led the delegation of the Organizing Committee at the Palazzo del Quirinale and was subsequently also received by the president emeritus of the Italian Republic Giorgio Napolitano.

Following some missionary trips to India and Africa - and felt the need to offer concrete support to the disadvantaged even and first of all in his own nation - he founded "Christian House" based in Naples, of which he holds the office of President.

He is an active disseminator on local and national TV programs with history, politics and religion programs. He interviewed five Nobel Prizes (Rita Levi Montalcini, Lech Walesa, Sharin Ebadi, Claude Cohen-Tannoudji, Mikail Gorbachev), heads of state, representatives of institutions, businessmen, and influencers.

In 2015 he is promoter in Naples, in the Scampia district, of a historic conference on the theme "Faith and Science" with prof. Antonino Zichichi. At the Pontifical Lateran University he interviewed the world's guru No. 1 on the topic of leadership John Maxwell, in October 2016.

In 2018 he interviewed the most well-known Italian science writer: Piero Angela.

In February 2018 in Florida, interviewed the most important living evangelist: dr. **Reinhard Bonnke**.

In June 2018 he met in Moscow the Nobel Peace Prize and former president of the Soviet Union **Mikail Gorbachev**.

Both in 2016 and in 2017 I was among the participants in Washington of the "National Prayer Breakfast", the prayer breakfast that every year is held with the President of the United States of America together with members of the American Congress and delegates from all over the world.

He promotes, organizes, and manages organizational, strategic and communicative aspects (as a press office) of national events with thousands of participants.

In 2018 he was hired as a media specialist for the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association's My Hope Italia project.

In 2019 he made a long interview with President Mikail Gorbachev exclusively worldwide on the occasion of the thirtieth anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall and the launch of the Magazine he directed and founded: **Real Inside Magazine**.

In 2020 TV2000 broadcasts a documentary produced and directed by Alessandro Iovino: "Discovering the Book of Books" dedicated to the Bible Museum in Washington DC. It was then dubbed in Arabic and broadcast exclusively on Noursat TV, the most important and ancient Christian television channel in Arabic.



In 2020 he founded the communication and public relations agency "Iovino&Partners".

He collaborates with the Andrea Bocelli Foundation, for which he has promoted fundraising events both in the USA and in Italy.

He produced the reportage "My American Dream" in which he interviews actor Salvatore Esposito, between Naples, Rome and New York.

His interviews, his social profiles and his blog are followed every month on the web by tens of thousands of people.

Married, he has two sons.
